## **AUC cautions Albertans about individuals falsely claiming to represent the AUC**

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) is warning Albertans of individuals falsely claiming to represent the AUC and approaching homeowners with offers related to energy rates, solar panels or roofing services.

The AUC does not conduct door-to-door sales and does not sell or promote products or services of any kind.

Anyone contacted by an individual claiming to represent the AUC in this manner is advised not to engage and report the incident to their local authority.

The AUC is an independent, quasi-judicial agency of the province of Alberta. The AUC regulates investor-owned natural gas, electric and water utilities and certain municipally owned electric utilities to ensure that customers receive safe and reliable service at just and reasonable rates. The Commission also ensures that electric facilities are built, operated, and decommissioned in an efficient and environmentally responsible way. In addition, the AUC provides regulatory oversight of Alberta's wholesale electricity market and the province's retail gas and electricity markets.
