

Notice of applications Oyen 1 Solar Project

UK Solar East Ltd. has filed applications for a solar power plant and a substation located in Special Area No. 3

Proceeding 29307 Applications 29307-A001 and 29307-A002

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC), the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the power plant and the substation development applications in Proceeding 29307. If you feel you may be affected by these applications, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

Written submissions are due November 4, 2024.

UK Solar East Ltd., a wholly owned subsidiary of Universal Kraft Canada Renewables Ltd., has applied for approval to construct and operate a 400-megawatt solar power plant and the associated Fair Acres 1162S Substation, designated as the Oyen 1 Solar Project.

The project would be sited on approximately 1,450 acres of privately owned cultivated land, approximately 13.2 kilometres northwest of the town of Oyen. The project area is shown in the map included with this notice. The project would cover the following locations:
