**Request for abeyance**

1. On May 27, 2024, counsel for Acestes Power ULC requested that the Alberta Utilities Commission place this proceeding into abeyance because it believes that the current regulatory environment for renewable energy development on good quality agricultural land is sufficiently unclear that it is not prepared to proceed at this time. Acestes indicated that it will wait to see what policy and legislative changes are brought forward by the provincial government prior to the end of 2024<sup>1</sup> and how these affect the Commission's regulatory processes before making the decision whether to proceed with the applications.
2. The Commission considers Acestes' request to be reasonable and has therefore decided to place this proceeding into abeyance. All previously scheduled procedural steps, including the filing of evidence and the scheduled oral hearing dates, are therefore suspended until further notice.
3. The Commission requires Acestes to provide the Commission with an update on the status of its applications **no later than by 4 p.m. on Friday, January 31, 2025.**
