

# Notice of applications Oyen 2 Solar Project

## UK Solar West Ltd. has filed applications for a solar power plant and a substation located in Special Area No. 3

### Proceeding 29819 Applications 29819-A001 and 29819-A002

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC), the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the power plant and the substation development applications in Proceeding 29819. If you feel you may be affected by these applications, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

### Written submissions are due April 3, 2025.

UK Solar West Ltd., a wholly owned subsidiary of Universal Kraft Canada Renewables Ltd., has applied for approval to construct and operate a 162-megawatt solar power plant and associated substation, designated as the Oyen 2 Solar Project.

The project would be sited on approximately 959 acres of privately owned cultivated land, approximately 14.5 kilometres northwest of the town of Oyen. The project area is shown in the map included with this notice. The project would cover the following locations:
