Eastervale Solar Inc. has filed applications for a solar power plant and a substation in the Municipal District of Provost No. 52

Proceeding 30067 Applications 30067-A001 and 30067-A002

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC), the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the solar power plant and substation development applications in Proceeding 30067. If you feel you may be affected by these applications, you can request to participate and provide input to the AUC before it makes its decision.

You can request to participate by registering and filing a statement of intent to participate by July 21, 2025.

Eastervale Solar Inc. has applied to construct and operate a 300-megawatt solar power plant located in portions of eight quarter sections, approximately 10 kilometres southwest of the village of Hughenden.
